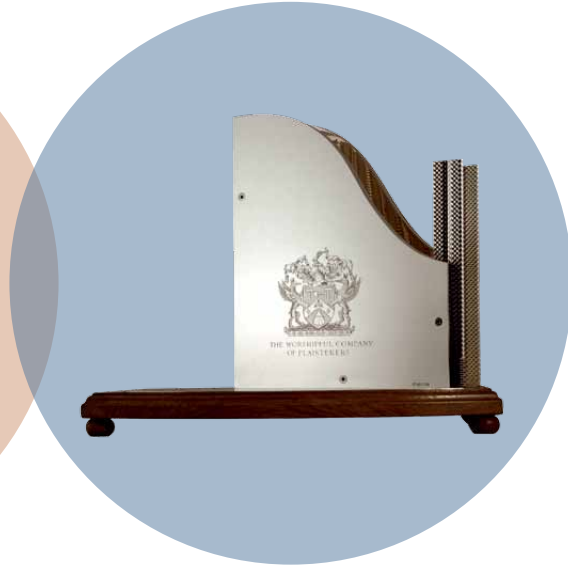

Snelling Cup

Plastering

- Established to promote the training of plasterers of all ages to become fully qualified and fully skilled
- To encourage independent training providers to attain and maintain standards in plastering
- It also recognises achievement in producing practical plastering craftsmen whose all-round ability will make them fully employable in their chosen field
- The Snelling Cup will be awarded to the independent training provider who, in the view of the Judging Panel, has attained the best conversion of registration to achievements of NVQ/SVQ levels 2&3 ICA/ACA and Diploma level 2&3 **during the period 1st January to 31st December 2010.**

British Gypsum Trophy

Drylining

- Established to promote the training of dryliners of all ages to become fully qualified and fully skilled
- To encourage independent training providers to attain and maintain standards in drylining
- It also recognises achievement in producing practical drylining craftsmen whose all-round ability will make them fully employable in their chosen field
- The British Gypsum Trophy will be awarded to the independent training provider who, in the view of the Judging Panel, has attained the best conversion of registration to achievements of NVQ level 2/ICA/ and Diploma **during the period 1st January to 31st December 2010.**

Rules of Entry - Please read carefully

1. Training providers must be registered with an awarding body (Construction Awards / Edexcel).
2. Training providers must submit the number of candidates who have registered for qualification NVQ2/SVQ2/NVQ3/SVQ3/ICA/ACA and Diplomas.
3. They must also provide the number of NVQ2/NVQ3/ICA/ACA and Diploma qualifications that they have achieved.
4. The period for which this information is required is 1st January to 31st December 2010.
5. The basis for determining the winner of the Snelling Cup and The British Gypsum Trophy will be the greatest number of achievements at both NVQ2/SVQ2/NVQ3/SVQ3/ICA/ACA and Diploma levels compared to the number of registrations.
6. A Training Provider may enter for one or both awards and should use the same reply form.
7. All entries must be accompanied with a print out from your awarding body verifying registrations/achievements and course type for the set date parameters.
8. The Judging Panel's decision will be final.
